No other hardwood provides the features of Teak: Beautiful honey brown shine; no mildew, mold or rotting; resistant to decay; not slippery even when wet; temperature neutral and no splintering. This makes Le click Teak Interlocking Flooring the preferred solution for decks in combination with pools and spas, both in- and outdoors.

- Teak wood is known and loved for its durability, resistance to weather, bugs, mold and mildew, its temperature neutrality and softness in touch
- PVC backing allows flexing of the tiles and provides the necessary distance between the surface and the wood to allow air circulation to dry after rain or snow.





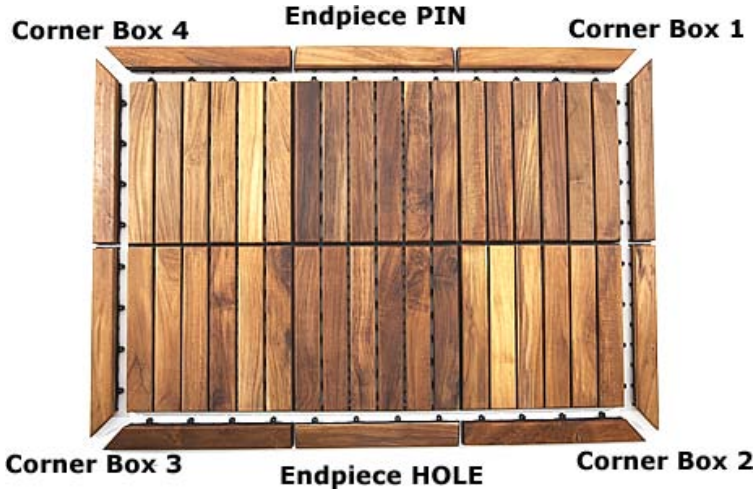
The Project with Le click is fast and neither requires building permits nor professional installation support!

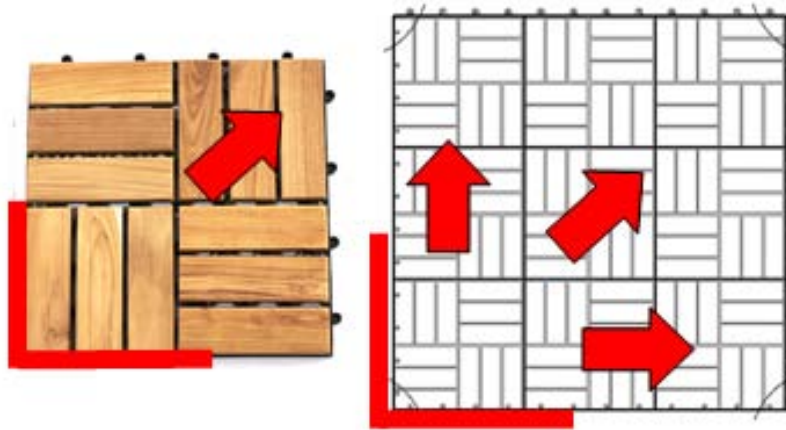
*Le click projects are as simple as 1-2-3:
Measure, buy, click the tiles!*

1. Measure the area surface you wish to cover
2. Buy the desired style by boxes of 10 tiles per box.
Each tile covers 1 square foot, so one Box of Le click will give you 10sf of flooring
3. Click the tiles into each other and within minutes your floor is done.

You may also consider:

- Optional corner and end trims are available and can be bought after the project is finished.
- If installed on a slippery surface like tile, marble or laminate flooring products, you may consider to use the ANTI-SLIP rubber knobs to stop the Teak tiles from sliding.





Before you click the first tile: Some considerations how to start the Project!



All you need to review is from which side or corner you want to start clicking the tiles.

- The easiest way is to start in a corner where the tile perfectly fits with the pin (straight) side of the tile in the corner.
- This leaves the loop side of the tile open and allows easy click in of the next tile.
- **Absolutely no effort, hammer, glue or nail is required to lay the floor. This is what makes Le click the preferred interlocking flooring solution in the market!**



Fitting the Le click Teak Tiles in a given space: Can we cut the tiles?

YES! The tiles can be cut, only considerations are:

- Mark the tile also on the underside where it should be cut and review if the cutting line is in contact with a screw.
- Move screws from one backing-hole to another for two reasons: First of all to avoid cutting through them, secondly to fix each slat with at least two screws.
- In an area where there is frequent traffic each Teak slat needs to be attached by at least two screws on the backing. This is the limitation of cutting the tile and varies with the chosen style.
- Always wear safety glasses and make sure to use new blades for cutting. Teak is a very hard wood and best results are given with sharpest and thin blades.
